X/4 C/S -- RADIO EMPLOYEES DEMAND TROOP WITHDRAWAL

MUNICH, AUG. 23 -- (CMD) -- THE EMPLOYEES OF ALL "FREE" CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO AND TELEVISION STATIONS TODAY CALLED FOR THE OCCUPATION TROOPS TO WITHDRAW FROM MAIN BROADCASTING INSTALLATIONS. THE CALL WAS REPORTED BY RADIO BRNO.

THE EMPLOYEES SAID THEY MADE THE CALL TO BE ABLE TO INFORM THE PEOPLE AFTER THE RETURN FROM MOSCOW OF PRESIDENT LUDVIK SVOBODA ABOUT THE RESULT OF THE NEGOTIATIONS.

"EVACUATE THE MAIN BUILDINGS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO AND TELEVISION AND ENABLE THE TRANSMITTERS TO WORK SO THAT THE PEOPLE OF OUR COUNTRY COULD HEAR THE WORDS OF THE REPUBLIC'S PRESIDENT AFTER HIS RETURN FROM MOSCOW...", THE RADIO SAID.
