

STOCKHOLM, AUG 23 -- (RFE SPECIAL/PURRE) -- THE STUDENTS OF FOUR OUT OF SWEDEN'S FIVE UNIVERSITIES LAST NIGHT ADOPTED PROTEST RESOLUTIONS AGAINST THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THE GENERAL UNION OF THE STUDENTS OF THE STOCKHOLM UNIVERSITY DEMANDED IN ITS RESOLUTION "AN IMMEDIATE WITHDRAWAL OF FOREIGN TROOPS" FROM CZECHOSLOVAKIA'S TERRITORY AND EXPRESSED ITS PROTEST AGAINST "THE UNLAWFUL AND CYNICAL AGGRESSION OF THE INVADING COUNTRIES AGAINST CZECHOSLOVAKIA."

THE GENERAL UNION OF UPPSALA UNIVERSITY'S STUDENTS HELD A MEETING THURSDAY NIGHT IN THE FESTIVITY HALL OF THE UNIVERSITY AND ADOPTED A RESOLUTION SHARPLY CONDEMNING THE "AGGRESSION OF THE WARSAW PACT COUNTRIES." THE RESOLUTION WAS SENT BY CABLE TO THE GOVERNMENTS OF THE USSR, EAST GERMANY, HUNGARY AND BULGARIA AS WELL AS TO THE PRESIDIUMS OF THE COMMUNIST PARTIES IN THESE COUNTRIES.

THE STUDENTS OF THE UMEAA UNIVERSITY EXPRESSED IN THEIR RESOLUTION THEIR "DISGUST" WITH THE SOVIET AGGRESSION AND "SUPPORT FOR THE FREEDOM STRUGGLE OF THE CZECH PEOPLE."

IN GOTHENBURG, THE UNION OF THE STUDENTS OF THE ARTS FACULTY SET UP PROTEST LISTS AND ASKED THEIR MEMBERS TO PUT THEIR SIGNATURES TO IT. SEVERAL HUNDRED STUDENTS SIGNED DURING THE FIRST HOUR LAST NIGHT. THE LISTS ARE TO BE FORWARDED TO THE SOVIET EMBASSY, A SPOKESMAN OF THE UNION SAID.

IN ADDITION TO ITS PROTEST RESOLUTION, THE STOCKHOLM STUDENT UNION RESOLVED TO UNDERTAKE THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE UPKEEP OF ALL AND ANY CZECH OSLOVAK STUDENTS CURRENTLY ON A VISIT TO SWEDEN.
