C/S - RUMANIANS DEMAND END TO INTERVENTION (RELEADS CN 165)

VIENNA, AUG 23, REUTER - WORKERS AT A RUMANIAN LIBERATION DAY PARADE IN BUCHAREST TODAY DEMANDED THE IMMEDIATE END OF MILITARY INTERVENTION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA, THE RUMANIAN AGERPRESS NEWS AGENCY REPORTED.

PRESIDENT CEAUSESCU, PRIME MINISTER ION GHEORGHE MAURER AND OTHER LEADERS WATCHED THE FOUR-HOUR MILITARY PARADE AND WORKERS DEMONSTRATION IN AIRMENS SQUARE.

DURING THE WORKERS DEMONSTRATION , THE AGENCY SAID, "PEOPLE EXPRESSED THEIR WARM SOLIDARITY WITH THE BROTHER PEOPLE OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA IN THE DIFFICULT MOMENTS THROUGH WHICH THEY ARE PASSING.

"THEY DEMANDED THE IMMEDIATE CESSATION OF MILITARY INTERVENTION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND THE CREATION OF CONDITIONS IN WHICH THE CZECH AND SLOVAK PEOPLES, UNDER THE LEADERSHIP OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY, COULD CONTINUE THE WORK OF PERFECTING THE SOCIALIST SYSTEM."
