X/4 CS - YUGOSLAV CENTRAL COMMITTEE IN SESSION

MUNICH, AUG 23 (CMD) - THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF THE YUGOSLAV LEAGUE OF COMMUNISTS BEGAN A SESSION TO CONSIDER THE CZECHOSLOVAK SITUATION THIS AFTERNOON.

RADIO BELGRADE SAID THE MEETING GOT UNDERWAY ABOUT 1700 M.T. UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF PRESIDENT MARSHAL JOSIP BROZ TITO.
