X/4 C/S - 1ST ADD. CZECHOSLOVAK AMATEUR BROADCASTERS (CN 237)

XXX CZECHOSLOVAKIA

RADIO PLZEN QUOTED THE NORTH BOHEMIAN RADIO AT
USTI NAD LABEM AS HAVING WARNED ALL AMATEUR RADIO
OPERATORS OWNING TRANSMITTERS THAT OCCUPATION TROOPS
ARE SEARCHING THEIR FLATS AND ARE CONFISCATING THE
RADIOS.

A SIMILAR ACTION MAY BE EXPECTED IN PRAGUE AND OTHER
CITIES, THE RADIO SAID, ADDING THAT ALL RADIO
AMATEURS WITH THEIR OWN TRANSMITTERS SHOULD MOVE THEIR APPARATUS
AND SHOULD NOT RPT NOT HAND THEM OVER TO THE OCCUPATION
UNITS.

AN EARLIER PLZEN BROADCAST, MONITORED IN COLOGNE AT
11.40 A.M. SAID:

"WE CALL ON ALL RADIO STATIONS OF THE WORLD. WE CALL
ON ALL WORLD AGENCIES. GIVE TO ALL TRADE UNION ORGANIZATIONS OF
THE WORLD'S WORKERS AND ALL TRADE UNION ORGANIZATIONS OF THE
WHOLE WORLD'S FLYING PERSONNEL THIS DEMAND:

"THE WORKERS IN THE CSSR REQUEST THAT YOU IMMEDIATELY
REFUSE (TO SUPPLY) FUEL AND REFUSE TO LOAD OR UNLOAD SHIPS
AND AIRCRAFT OF STATES WHICH ARE OCCUPYING OUR COUNTRY,
UNTIL THE COMPLETE WITHDRAWAL OF ALL OCCUPATION ARMIES FROM
THE WHOLE OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA."

THE BROADCAST ALSO SAID THE MESSAGE WAS DIRECTED AT THE
GOVERNMENTS OF THE OCCUPYING STATES.
