

X/4 C/S - BILAK AND INDRA NOT RPT NOT RE-ELECTED, RADIO SAYS

MUNICH, AUGUST 23 (CMD)- A DELEGATE TO THE EXTRAORDINARY 14TH CONGRESS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK PARTY, WRITER JAN TREFULKA, HAS SAID THAT SLOVAK PARTY LEADER VASIL BILAK AND FORMER CZECHOSLOVAK PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE SECRETARY ALOIS INDRA WERE NOT RPT NOT ELECTED TO THE NEW CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY.

JAN TREFULKA MADE THE STATEMENT AT A MEETING AT THE PHILOSOPHICAL FACULTY IN BRNO TONIGHT.

"RADIO FREE BRNO" CARRIED SOME EXCERPTS OF TREFULKA'S REPLIES ON THE MEETING YESTERDAY IN PRAGUE OF THE EXTRAORDINARY PARTY CONGRESS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY.

ASKED WHETHER THE PEOPLE WHO WENT TO MOSCOW WITH CZECHOSLOVAK PRESIDENT LUDVIK SVOBODA FOR TALKS ARE AUTHORIZED TO TALK ON BEHALF OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA, AS THEY ARE NO RPT NO LONGER MEMBERS OF THE NEW CENTRAL COMMITTEE OR OF THE GOVERNMENT, TREFULKA REPLIED:

"YOU HAVE IN MIND CONCRETELY COMRADES BILAK AND INDRA. I AM ALSO PRETTY ASTONISHED THAT EXACTLY THEY ARE GOING THERE (TO MOSCOW), BECAUSE, OF COURSE BY THEIR NOT HAVING BEEN ELECTED TO THE NEW CENTRAL COMMITTEE THEY DO NOT HAVE THE RIGHT TO REPRESENT THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY OR ANY GOVERNMENT FUNCTIONS..

TREFULKA SAID THAT BILAK HAD A FUNCTION IN SLOVAKIA, BUT HAD NO RPT NO FUNCTION IN THE REST OF THE COUNTRY. HE SAID THAT IN HIS OPINION BILAK AND INDRA WENT TO MOSCOW ON THE WISH OF THE "OTHER SIDE."
