CS - SOVIET ARMY COMMUNICATIONS BEING JAMMED

MOSCOW, AUG. 23, REUTER--MOSCOW RADIO CHARGED TONIGHT THAT CZECHOSLOVAKS WITH ILLEGAL TRANSMITTERS WERE JAMMING COMMUNICATIONS BETWEEN SOVIET ARMY UNITS OCCUPYING CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

MOSCOW RADIO SAID THE JAMMING SHOWED THAT A COUNTER-REVOLUTION HAD BEEN PLANNED IN ADVANCE IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND THAT "HELP CAME JUST IN TIME," A REFERENCE TO THE OCCUPATION.

THE RADIO ALSO ACCUSED THE WEST GERMAN ARMY OF SETTING UP TRANSMITTERS NEAR THE CZECHOSLOVAK BORDERS THAT PRETENDED TO BE CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO STATIONS AND BROADCAST "PROVOCATIONAL DECLARATIONS."
