

DUTCH POLICE GUARDS ON EMBASSIES INCREASED

THE HAGUE, AUG. 23 (RFE SPECIAL JM/RD) -- DUTCH POLICE HAVE BOLSTERED THEIR ALREADY BLANKET SECURITY PRECAUTIONS AROUND THE SOVIET, POLISH, HUNGARIAN AND BULGARIAN EMBASSIES IN THE HAGUE.

STUDENT PROTESTS IN AMSTERDAM, THE HAGUE, ROTTERDAM AND UNTRICHT THE PAST TWO NIGHTS HAVE BEEN LOUD, BUT LITTLE DAMAGE HAS BEEN DONE. ONE WINDOW IN THE SOVIET EMBASSY IN THE HAGUE WAS BROKEN, BUT POLICE HAD NOT RPT NOT MADE ANY ARRESTS.

RADIO FREE PLZEN CALLS GENEVA RED CROSS

MUNICH, AUG 23 (CMD)- THE CZECHOSLOVAK TRANSMITTER CALLING ITSELF RADIO FREE PLZEN TONIGHT CALLED ON THE GENEVA RED CROSS HEADQUARTERS TO "INFORM TRUTHFULLY THE ENTIRE WORLD ON THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA BY TROOPS OF THE WARSAW PACT."

THE RADIO BROADCAST THE APPEAL TO THE GENEVA RED CROSS CENTER IN CZECH, ENGLISH, GERMAN AND FRENCH.

THE RADIO SAID "LISTEN ONLY TO THE BROADCASTS OF THE LEGAL CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO AND INFORM TRUTHFULLY THE ENTIRE WORLD ON THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA BY TROOPS OF THE WARSAW PACT."

SWISS PARLIAMENT CALLS FOR RELEASE OF PRISONERS

BERN, AUGUST 23 (RFE SPECIAL)- THE FOREIGN POLICY COMMISSION OF THE SWISS PARLIAMENT TODAY CALLED FOR THE RELEASE OF ALL CZECHOSLOVAK PRISONERS AND THE WITHDRAWAL OF FOREIGN TROOPS FROM THE COUNTRY.

IN A STATEMENT RELEASED TODAY IT "SHARPLY CONDEMNED, BACKED BY THE SENTIMENTS OF THE SWISS PEOPLE, THE INTERVENTION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA."

THE COMMISSION SENT ITS DEEP SYMPATHY TO THE CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE.

DUTCH MUSICIANS, PARLIAMENTARIANS CANCEL POLISH VISIT

THE HAGUE, AUG 23 (RFE SPECIAL/JM/RD)- SEVERAL DUTCH MUSICIANS, A MUSICAL GROUP AND A PARLIAMENTARY DELEGATION HAVE CANCELLED SCHEDULED VISITS TO POLAND IN THE WAKE OF THE MILITARY OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THE SCHEDULED CONCERT TRIP IN POLAND OF THE DUTCH RESIDENCE ORCHESTRA HAS BEEN CANCELLED, IT WAS ANNOUNCED TODAY.

A PLANNED VISIT OF DUTCH PARLIAMENTARIANS TO WARSAW NEXT MONTH HAS ALSO BEEN CANCELLED, GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS SAID.

SEVERAL POPULAR SINGERS WHO WERE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE ANNUAL SOPOT MUSIC FESTIVAL IN POLAND HAVE ALSO CANCELLED PLANS TO ATTEND. SOME HAD ALSO PLANNED TO MAKE A CONCERT TOUR OF THE SOVIET UNION AFTER THE SOPOT FESTIVAL. THAT TOUR HAS ALSO BEEN CANCELLED.
