X/4 C/S -- YUGOSLAV COMMUNIST PARTY CONDEMNS INVASION (RELEADS CN 344)

BELGRADE, AUGUST 24 (CMD)-- THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF THE YUGOSLAV COMMUNIST PARTY LATE LAST NIGHT PASSED A RESOLUTION "CONDEMNING THE AGGRESSION CARRIED BY THE ARMED FORCES OF THE USSR, POLAND, GERMAN DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC, BULGARIA AND HUNGARY AGAINST CZECHOSLOVAKIA," SAID TANJUG.

THE TEXT OF THE RESOLUTION WILL BE PUBLISHED TOMORROW.

TANJUG SAID THAT PRESIDENT TITO MADE AN INTRODUCTORY REPORT ON THE SITUATION, AND WAS FOLLOWED BY SPEAKERS WHO "CONDEMNED THE AGGRESSION AGAINST FREEDOM, AND THE INVIOABLE RIGHT OF A PEOPLE TO CHOOSE BY ITSELF THE ROAD OF ITS SOCIALIST DEVELOPMENT."
