C/S -- 12TH ADD COUNCIL MEETS (CN 42) XXX DEVELOPMENT.

HE SAID THE INVASION ENCOURAGES THE USE OF FORCE AND VIOLATES THE VRY FOUNDATIONS OF PEACEFUL COEXISTENCE.

THE PROTAGONISTS OF A POLICY OF FORCES MUST REALIZE THAT THERE CAN BE NO PEACE IN THE WORLD UNDER SUCH A POLICY," HE SAID.

"THE PEOPLE OF YUGOSLAVIA, WHO IN THEIR TIME HAVE HAD TO FIGHT AGAINST INTERVENTION AND INTERFERENCE, CANNOT RECONCILE THEMSELVES TO A POLICY OF FORCE."
