C/S - INDONESIAN STUDENTS STAGE ANTI-SOVIET PROTEST

DJAKARTA, AUG. 24, REUTER - ABOUT 200
INDONESIAN STUDENTS STORMED THE SOVIET EMBASSY COMPOUND
HERE TODAY AFTER PAINTING A RED SKULL AND CROSS BONES OVER
THE BRASS NAME PLATE IN PROTEST AGAINST THE INVASION
OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

ARMY TROOPS WITH FIXED BAYONETS DROVE THE STUDENTS OUT
OF THE COMPOUND MINUTES AFTER THEY HAD MOVED IN BUT POLICE
LATER LET THEM HAND A PROTEST NOTE TO AN EMBASSY OFFICIAL.

ABOUT 100 SECURITY GUARDS AND AN ARMoured CAR ARRIVED
AT THE EMBASSY GATES WHEN THE STUDENTS STARTED GATHERING
OUTSIDE AROUND DAWN.

BEFORE THEY MOVED INTO THE COMPOUND, SOME STUDENTS
RAISED A PLACARD WITH THE WORDS "UGLY RUSSIANS
GO HOME" ON THE EMBASSY FLAGPOLE AND DAUBED THE WHITE-
WASHED BUILDING WITH ANTI-SOVIET SLOGANS.

FROM THE SOVIET EMBASSY THE STUDENTS MARCHED TO THE
POLISH EMBASSY, HAULED DOWN THE MISSION FLAG, AND THEN
TO THE EAST GERMAN CONSULATE WHERE ONE
DEMONSTRATOR CLIMBED ON THE ROOF TO TEAR DOWN THE COAT OF ARMS.

SECURITY GUARDS STOOD BY AS THEY SMASHED THE WINDOWS
OF A BUS PARKED IN THE CONSULATE COMPOUND, SMASHED A
GLASS DISPLAY CASE AND TRAMPLED LEAFLETS AND PHOTOGRAPHS.
