C/S - 1ST ADD - DUBCEK AND CERNIK IN MOSCOW (CN 110) XXX ARRIVED

THE STATION SAID "DR HUSAK PROMISED THAT IMMEDIATELY AFTER HIS RETURN HE WOULD INFORM THEM ABOUT THE MOSCOW TALKS ON ONE OF THE FREE TRANSMITTERS."

THE BROADCAST SAID THAT OCCUPATION TROOPS HAD ON FRIDAY MORNING "LED OUT" OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE BUILDING IN BRATISLAVA FIVE MEMBERS OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF THE SLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY AND THE CHAIRMAN OF THE SLOVAK NATIONAL COUNCIL.

"THEY RETURNED IN THE EVENING", THE RADIO SAID.

IN QUOTING RADIO NITRA, RADIO PRAGUE SAID THAT THE ITEM CORRECTED EARLIER INFORMATION ABOUT THE "ARREST" OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEMBERS AND CHAIRMAN OF THE NATIONAL COUNCIL.

EARLIER TODAY A STATION CALLING ITSELF RADIO DANUBE SAID THAT THE COMMANDER OF THE OCCUPATION TROOPS IN BRATISLAVA LAST NIGHT ARRIVED AT THE SLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE AND TOOK AWAY ALL MEMBERS OF THE SLOVAK PRESIDUM.

IT WAS NOT CLEAR WHETHER RADIO NITRA WAS CORRECTING THE REPORT OF RADIO DANUBE OR WHETHER THE EVENTS REPORTED BY RADIO DANUBE OCCURRED LATER.
