C/S -- PRAGUE SAYS PLZEN PRAVDA REAPPEARS

MUNICH, AUG 24 (CMD) -- THE FREE CZECHOSLOVAK STATION IN PRAGUE REPORTS TODAY THAT THE PLZEN DAILY, PRAVDA, HAS BEGUN TO REAPPEAR AFTER THE SOVIET OCCUPIERS LEFT THE EDITORIAL OFFICE OF THE DAILY.

EARLIER, THE FREE CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO CALLED ON THE PLZEN PRINTING WORKERS TO GO TO THEIR WORKING PLACES, AS THE OCCUPIERS HAD LEFT THE PUBLISHING HOUSE.

HEATH STATEMENT

LONDON AUGUST 24--(RFE SPECIAL/HOOD)--CONSERVATIVE PARTY LEADER EDWARD HEATH SAID ON ARRIVAL TODAY AT LONDON AIRPORT FROM A FOREIGN TRIP CUT SHORT BECAUSE OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK CRISIS:

"NO CONDEMNATION OF THE ACTION CAN NOT RPT NOT BE TOO GREAT. WHAT THIS HAS DONE IS TO REVEAL IN ALL ITS STARK NAKEDNESS THE HARSH REALITIES OF SOVIET COMMUNIST POWERS AND POLICIES."

THIRD DAY OF FAST

LONDON AUGUST 24--(RFE SPECIAL/HOOD)--MISS PAT ARROWSMITH, 38-YEAR-OLD TYPIST, BEGAN HER THIRD DAY OF FASTING NEAR THE RUSSIAN AND CZECHOSLOVAK EMBASSIES IN LONDON TODAY AND SAID SHE WAS FEELING FIT AND WELL.

MISS ARROWSMITH, WHO BEGAN HER PROTEST EARLY THURSDAY MORNING, IS LIVING ON A DIET OF WATER AND PROPOSES TO DO SO FOR SEVEN DAYS.

LONDON AUGUST 24--(RFE SPECIAL/HOOD)--THE ARCHBISHOP OF CANTERBURY, DR MICHAEL RAMSEY, BEFORE THE OPENING TODAY OF THE LAST DAY OF THE LAMBETH CONFERENCE OF BISHOPS OF THE ANGLICAN COMMUNION FROM AROUND THE WORLD, LED PRAYERS IN WESTMINSTER ABBEY FOR THE PEOPLE OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA "THAT THEY MAY BE GIVEN ENDURANCE, PEACE OF MIND AND STEADFASTNESS.

"WE PRAY FOR THE RULERS OF RUSSIA THAT THEY MAY BE BROUGHT TO SENSE AND WISDOM AND REALITY," HE PRAYED.

"WE PRAY FOR THE LEADERS OF EVERY COUNTRY INVOLVED IN THE PRESENT CRISIS THAT GREAT WISDOM MAY BE GIVEN TO THEM."
