X/4 C/S -- BORBA ON HUMAN DRAMA OF OCCUPATION SOLDIERS

MUNICH, AUG 24 (CMD) -- THE BELGRADE DAILY, BORBA, SAID TODAY THAT THE WORKING PEOPLE AND COMMUNISTS OF THE FIVE WARSAW PACT COUNTRIES WHICH OCCUPIED CZECHOSLOVAKIA HAVE FOUND THEMSELVES IN "A TRAGIC POSITION."

"THEY ARE ASKED TO APPROVE THE SHAMEFUL ACT OF AGGRESSION AGAINST SOCIALIST CZECHOSLOVAKIA AS A MATTER WHICH IS USEFUL FOR SOCIALISM AND PEACE. THE ORGANIZERS OF THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA, JUDGING BY EVERYTHING, COUNTED ON THAT THEMSELVES," BORBA ADDED.

RADIO ZAGREB QUOTED BORBA AS SAYING: "THEY DID NOT RPT NOT DARE TELL EVEN THE SOLDIERS WHO PARTICIPATED IN THE INTERVENTION WHAT TASK THEY HAVE TO EXECUTE.

"ALMOST SHOCKING ARE THE SCENES OF ASTONISHMENT AND EMBARRASSMENT OF THOSE SOLDIERS AT THE MOMENTS WHEN THEY FOUND THEMSELVES IN THE ROLE OF THE OCCUPIER OF A PEACEFUL SOCIALIST NATION.

"THOSE HUMAN DRAMAS ARE TOO PAINFUL. HE WHO PROVOKED THEM WILL HAVE, EVENTUALLY, TO RENDER ACCOUNTS TO HIS PEOPLE," BORBA ADDED.
