

X/4 C/S - YUGOSLAVS HELP CZECHOSLOVAK TOURISTS

MUNICH, AUG 24 (CMD) - RADIO ZAGREB REPORTED TODAY THAT THE YUGOSLAV PEOPLE, AS A SIGN OF SOLIDARITY WITH THE CZECHS AND THE SLOVAKS, ARE HELPING CZECHOSLOVAK TOURISTS IN YUGOSLAVIA WITH ACCOMODATION, FOOD, AND TRANSPORTATION FREE OF CHARGE.

IN ZAGREB, WHERE AT PRESENT THERE ARE 2,000 CZECHOSLOVAKS, 1,500 OF THEM ARE ACCOMODATED IN STUDENTS HOMES AND CAMPING PLACES, AND SEVERAL HUNDREDS WERE TAKEN BY ZAGREB CITIZENS TO THEIR HOMES.

PEOPLE COME AND BRING GIFTS TO CZECHOSLOVAK CHILDREN. A ZAGREB CANDY PLANT DONATED ABOUT 60 KILOGRAMS OF CANDY AND A GREAT QUANTITY OF BISCUITS, WHEREAS A WINE ENTERPRISE DONATED A GREAT QUANTITY OF DRINK. A DAIRY SHOP SENT A TRUCKLOAD OF MILK, CHEESE, AND CREAM, AND PROMISED TO CONTINUE THAT SUPPLY IN THE FUTURE.

A TOBACCO PLANT IN ZAGREB PROMISED TO DELIVER TOBACCO AND CIGARETS REGULARLY, AND TAXI DRIVERS IN ZAGREB ARE TRANSPORTING CZECHOSLOVAK TOURISTS FREE OF CHARGE. THE TRANSPORTATION ENTERPRISE, AUTOTRANS, ALLOWS CZECHOSLOVAK TOURISTS TO USE THE BUSES OF THE ENTERPRISE FREE OF CHARGE ALL OVER YUGOSLAVIA.

IN KARLOVAC, ANOTHER CROATIAN TOWN, A FUND FOR 450 CZECHOSLOVAK TOURISTS RECEIVED IN A SINGLE DAY 40,000 NEW DINARS (12.50 NEW DINARS ARE EQUAL TO ONE DOLLAR) FROM CITIZENS.

IN MANY OTHER CITIES AND TOWNS, PROVISIONAL INFORMATION AND ACCOMODATION CENTRES RENDER ALL NECESSARY AID TO CZECHOSLOVAK TOURISTS, RADIO ZAGREB SAID. (RADIO ZAGREB DOMESTIC/M, AUG 24, 0600)
