X/4 C/S - MARTIAL LAW TO BE LIFTED IN TRENCIN ?

MUNICH, AUG 24 (CMD) - A CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO STATION SAID TODAY THE SOVIET COMMANDER IN TRENCIN (WESTERN SLOVAKIA) HAD PROMISED TO LIFT MARTIAL LAW IN THAT TOWN.

THE REPORT WAS CONTAINED IN A BROADCAST OF "THE LEGAL TRANSMITTER OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO IN SLOVAKIA."

AND RADIO FREE KRIVAN (SLOVAKIA) REPORTED THAT AMATEUR RADIO OPERATORS IN THE MARTIN DISTRICT (NORTHERN SLOVAKIA) WERE DEMANDING THAT THEIR TRANSMITTERS, WHICH HAD BEEN CONFISCATED BY SECURITY FORCES, BE RETURNED TO THEM.

ACCORDING TO THE RADIO, THE AMATEUR OPERATORS SAID THIS CONFISCATION WAS AN "ACT OF COLLABORATION." (RADIO FREE KRIVAN, DOMESTIC/M, AUG 24, 0955)

"THE LEGAL TRANSMITTER OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO IN SLOVAKIA" REPORTED TODAY (AT 0558) THAT THE MEMBERS OF THE HUNGARIAN OCCUPATION FORCES "HAVE ISOLATED SOUTHERN DISTRICTS FROM OTHER PARTS OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA."
