X/4 C/S - FREE PRAGUE: INDRA, KOLDER DENY GUILT FOR INTERVENTION

MUNICH, AUG 24 (CMD)- RADIO FREE PRAGUE SAID TODAY THAT ALOIS INDRA AND DRAHOMIR KOLDER "HAVE DENIED IN MOSCOW THAT THEY HAD REQUESTED THE ALLIED INTERVENTION".

THE RADIO ADDED THAT IT HEARD THIS REPORT FROM VARIOUS SOURCES BUT SO FAR THE REPORT IS UNCONFIRMED.

"WE REPEAT - WE DO NOT RPT NOT KNOW WHETHER IT IS TRUE", THE RADIO SAID.

"IN ANY CASE, SUCH A DEED COULD, ACCORDING TO OUR OPINION, BE A REIMBURSEMENT FOR THE BETRAYAL THAT THE COLLABORATORS COMMITTED", RADIO FREE PRAGUE SAID.
