MUNICH, AUG 24 (CMD)- A REPORTER OF THE FREE TRANSMITTER OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO IN SLOVAKIA ON THE DANUBE SAID TODAY HE WAS TOLD BY ALEXANDER DUBCEK'S SON PALO THAT THE NEIGHBOURS ARE TAKING GOOD CARE OF HIS FAMILY.

THE REPORTER ADDED THAT PALO IS ATTENDING A MEDICAL SCHOOL WHILE HIS YOUNGER, 18-YEAR-OLD BROTHER PETER IS IN EGYPT WHERE HE WENT ON VACATION.

ACCORDING TO THE RADIO, PALO DESCRIBED AS NONSENSE A REPORT SAYING PETER HAD ASKED FOR ASYLUM IN EGYPT.

"HE WILL RETURN."
