X/4 C/S - 1ST ADD - RADIO DESCRIBES PRAGUE SITUATION (CN 146)

RADIO CZECHOSLOVAKIA ONE SAID THAT IT IS HARDLY POSSIBLE TO FIND IN PRAGUE A STREET SIGN.

IN MANY CASES THE NUMBER PLATES ON HOUSES DISAPPEARED, TOO.

THE RADIO SAID "HALF OF PRAGUE HAS BEEN WRITTEN ALL OVER" IN RUSSIAN CYRILLIC.

SLOGANS SUCH AS "WE ARE FOR DUBCEK," "WE WANT SOCIALISM AND THIS WILL NOT RPT NOT BE PREVENTED EVEN BY OUR 'FRIENDS'" ARE WRITTEN IN RUSSIAN, THE RADIO SAID.

OTHER SLOGANS WRITTEN IN RUSSIAN SAID "LET ALL OF US BE DUBCEK-LIKE."

VERY OFTEN ONE SEES IN PRAGUE THE INSCRIPTION SAYING "LENIN WAKE UP -- BREZHNEV HAS GONE MAD," THE RADIO SAID.

THE RADIO SAID THE SLOGANS WERE VERY IGENIOUS, STRIKING AND WITTY. IT ADDED THAT PEOPLE HAVE UNDERSTOOD THAT ON THE FOURTH DAY "THE OCCUPIERS HAVE NOT RPT NOT SUCCEEDED IN FINDING ANY QUISLING."

RADIO CZECHOSLOVAKIA ONE SHORTLY AFTER NOON TODAY QUOTED "RADIO NORTH BOHEMIA" AS REPORTING THAT GIANT TRANSPORT PLANES OF THE AN-22 TYPE FLEW TO THE ZATEC AIRPORT THROUGHOUT THE WHOLE NIGHT. ZATEC IS ABOUT 80 KILOMETERS WEST OF PRAGUE.
