X/4 CS - FREE RADIO WARNS AGAINST TELEVISION

MUNICH, AUG 24 (CMD)- RADIO FREE CENTRAL SLOVAKIA TODAY WARNED ITS LISTENERS AGAINST WATCHING PROGRAMS WHICH IT SAID WERE BEING BROADCAST AS OF THIS MORNING ON THE "FIRST, SECOND AND SEVENTH CHANNEL OF CZECHOSLOVAK TELEVISION."

THE RADIO SAID THE COMMAND OF THE EASTERN MILITARY REGION HAS ANNOUNCED IT HAS "NOTHING IN COMMON WITH THE INSTALLATION OF A TRANSMITTER IN TRENCIN (WESTERN SLOVAKIA) AND WITH ITS BROADCASTS."

THE SAME BROADCAST SAID THE OCCUPATION FORCES WERE STOPPING TRUCKS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK FOOD DISTRIBUTION ENTERPRISES MARKED JEDNOTA, ZDROJ, PEKARNE, MASO, ETC.

THE RADIO CALLED ON THE WORKERS OF THESE ENTERPRISES TO TRANSPORT FOOD IN VEHICLES WHICH ARE NOT RPT NOT MARKED; THE OCCUPATION SOLDIERS "ARE SEIZING SOME OF THE FOOD STUFFS," THE RADIO SAID.

THE RADIO SAID ALSO THAT IN THE PAST THREE DAYS OF OCCUPATION CZECHOSLOVAKIA'S VALUE OF PRODUCTION HAD DROPPED BY MORE THAN ONE BILLION (RPT BILLION) CROWNS. THE RADIO ADDED THAT THERE WERE ALSO OTHER LOSSES, LIKE DAMAGED PAVEMENTS BY TANKS, DESTROYED HOUSES, ETC.

RADIO FREE HRADEC KRALOVE SAID TODAY (AT 1404 MT) THAT POLISH HELICOPTERS HAD LANDED SOME 20 CIVILIANS IN THE AREA OF THIS TOWN. (RADIOS FREE CZECHOSLOVAKIA IN CENTRAL SLOVAKIA, 1100, 1020)
