

MOSCOW, AUG. 24, REUTER - THE SOVIET GOVERNMENT NEWSPAPER IZVESTIA ATTACKED RUMANIAN PRESIDENT AND COMMUNIST PARTY CHIEF NICOLAE CEAUSESCU TODAY FOR AIDING THE CZECHOSLOVAK "COUNTER-REVOLUTION" THROUGH HIS SPEECHES.

AS AN EXAMPLE OF MR. CEAUSESCU'S ALLEGED HELP TO COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARIES, IZVESTIA CITED HIS STATEMENT THAT "NO ONE CAN ACT AS AN ADVISOR OR MENTOR ON HOW AND IN WHAT WAY SOCIALISM SHOULD BE BUILT."

THE RUMANIAN LEADER HAS BEEN AMONG THE FOREMOST CRITICS OF THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA BY SOVIET AND WARSAW PACT TROOPS.

IZVESTIA, IN AN ARTICLE BY VLADIMIR KUDRYAVTSEV, SAID THE THESIS THAT EACH COUNTRY CHOOSES ITS OWN PATH TO SOCIALISM WAS CORRECT, BUT THIS THESIS WAS BEING ABUSED, IT ADDED.

"CERTAIN PEOPLE SO IGNORE THE PRINCIPLES THAT ARE COMMON TO ALL SOCIALIST COUNTRIES THAT THEY CONTRIBUTE TO THE CZECHOSLOVAK COUNTER-REVOLUTION IN ITS DESIRE TO BREAK CZECHOSLOVAKIA AWAY FROM THE SOCIALIST COMMONWEALTH.

"IN JUSTIFICATION OF THIS POSITION THEY ADVANCE THE THESIS THAT, AS N. CEAUSESCU SAID, "NO ONE CAN ACT AS AN ADVISOR OR MENTOR ON HOW AND IN WHAT WAY SOCIALISM SHOULD BE BUILT," IZVESTIA SAID.
