CS - 1ST ADD 1930 INTRO - BRITISH DEMONSTRATION (CN-230)

XXX CZECHOSLOVAKIA

OUTSIDE ONE OF THE LOCKED GATES ON THE EMBASSY ROAD, 28-YEAR-OLD SECRETARY PAT ARROWSMITH CONTINUED A FAST SHE BEGAN TWO DAYS AGO TO PROTEST AT THE SOVIET ACTION.

IN THE WEST ENGLAND CITY OF BRISTOL, SEVERAL HUNDRED PEOPLE JOINED AN ANTI-SOVIET MARCH THROUGH THE CITY STREETS ORGANISED BY LOCAL COMMUNISTS.

LONDONERS MOVED IN A CONTINUOUS STREAM THROUGH THE FOYER OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK EMBASSY TO SIGN A PETITION SUPPORTING THE DUBCEK GOVERNMENT.

ON A LAWN OUTSIDE THE EMBASSY LAY A LONE WREATH PLACED BY CZECHOSLOVAKS LIVING IN LONDON. A CARD SAID: "IN MEMORY OF ALL THE VICTIMS OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA."
