X/4 C/S - TITO, CEAUSESCU MEET ON YUGOSLAV-RUMANIAN BORDER

BELGRADE, AUG 24 (CMD)-- YUGOSLAV PRESIDENT TITO AND RUMANIAN COMMUNIST PARTY LEADER NICOLAE CEAUSESCU MET AT VRSAC NEAR THE YUGOSLAV-RUMANIAN (CORECT) FRONTIER TODAY, ACCORDING TO THE YUGOSLAV NEWS AGENCY.

"AN EXCHANGE OF VIEWS WAS MADE AT THE MEETING ABOUT QUESTIONS PERTAINING TO BILATERAL RELATIONS AND CURRENT INTERNATIONAL PROBLEMS OF INTEREST TO THE TWO COUNTRIES," TANJUG SAID.

THE TANJUG REPORT CONTINUED:

"OTHER YUGOSLAV PARTICIPANTS... WERE THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL OF THE FEDERATION AND THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE PRESIDENCY OF THE LEAGUE OF COMMUNISTS OF YUGOSLAVIA, EDVARD KARDELJ, MIJALKO TODOROVIC, VELJKO VLAHOVIC AND VLADIMIR POPOVIC, AS WELL AS THE YUGOSLAV AMBASSADOR TO BUCHAREST, JAKSA PETRIC.

"THE RUMANIAN PARTICIPANTS IN THE TALKS WERE THE VICE-PRESIDENT OF THE RUMANIAN STATE COUNCIL, EMIL BODNARAS, THE RUMANIAN AMBASSADOR TO BELGRADE, AUREL MALNASAN."
