

X/4 CURT - BUDAPEST ATTACKS CEAUSESCU

MUNICH, AUG 24 (CMD)- RADIO BUDAPEST ATTACKED TODAY RUMANIAN PARTY LEADER AND HEAD OF STATE NICOLAE CEAUSESCU FOR HIS STANDPOINT TAKEN AT THE EXTRAORDINARY MEETING OF THE RUMANIAN GRAND NATIONAL ASSEMBLY ON THURSDAY CONCERNING THE CZECHOSLOVAK SITUATION.

THE RADIO SAID NOBODY IS SURPRISED THAT THE "AID GIVEN BY THE FIVE FRATERNAL PARTIES TO CZECHOSLOVAKIA GAVE RISE TO HOT ANGER AMONG THE ENEMIES OF SOCIALISM," AND ADDED:

"BUT MILDLY SPEAKING IT GIVES CAUSE TO BE SURPRISED IF THE AID GIVEN BY THE FIVE FRIENDLY COUNTRIES IS MISINTERPRETED FROM THE SOCIALIST SIDE...."

"AND EXACTLY SUCH A THING HAPPENED AT THE EXTRAORDINARY MEETING OF THE RUMANIAN GRAND NATIONAL ASSEMBLY ON THURSDAY WHEN CEAUSESCU USED SEVERAL FORMULATIONS AND EXPRESSIONS IN HIS SPEECH WHICH CAUSED SERIOUS INDIGNATION AMONG THE PEOPLE OF THE FRATERNAL SOCIALIST COUNTRIES," THE RADIO SAID.

"THE RUMANIAN HEAD OF STATE SAID, FOR INSTANCE, THAT THE COLLECTIVE STEP OF THE FIVE COUNTRIES IS IN SHARP CONTRADICTION WITH THE RULES CHARACTERIZING THE MUTUAL RELATIONS OF THE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES."

THE RADIO SAID THAT "WE SHOULD RECALL THE BRATISLAVA DECLARATION WHICH CLEARLY SAID THAT THE DEFENCE OF SOCIALIST ACHIEVEMENTS AND RESULTS IS THE COMMON DUTY OF EVERY FRIENDLY COUNTRY AND THIS IMPORTANT NORM WAS ALSO ACKNOWLEDGED BY THE GENERAL SECRETARY OF THE RUMANIAN COMMUNIST PARTY WHEN HE RECENTLY VISITED PRAGUE."
