X/13 BRIT--BILAKS DAUGHTER REPORTED MISSING

LONDON, AUG. 24 (RFE SPECIAL/BUZEK/WELLS)-NADA BILAK, 18-YEAR-OLD DAUGHTER OF SLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY LEADER VASIL BILAK, HAS BEEN MISSING FOR TWO DAYS FROM THE INTERNATIONAL VOLUNTARY SERVICE CAMP IN BRITAIN WHERE SHE HAD BEEN WORKING THIS SUMMER, IT WAS LEARNED TODAY.

CAMP OFFICIALS HAVE TOLD POLICE IN BRITAIN THAT MISS BILAK LEFT THE CAMP AT WIGTON, NEAR CARLISLE, WITH TWO UNIDENTIFIED MEN WHO HAD COME TO TALK TO HER. THEY SAID SHE APPARENTLY LEFT VOLUNTARILY BUT DID NOT RPT NOT SAY WHERE SHE WAS GOING AND HAS NOT RPT NOT CONTACTED THE CAMP SINCE.

CZECHOSLOVAK EMBASSY OFFICIALS IN LONDON HAVE TOLD POLICE THEY KNOW NOTHING ABOUT HER DEPARTURE FROM THE CAMP OR HER PRESENT WHEREABOUTS AND ARE COOPERATING WITH THE POLICE INVESTIGATION. INTERPOL, THE INTERNATIONAL POLICE AGENCY, HAS ALSO BEEN NOTIFIED OF HER DISAPPEARANCE
