U.N. - MEXICO WANT ASSEMBLY SESSION ON C/S

MEXICO CITY, AUG 24, REUTER -- MEXICO WILL SEEK TO MOVE THE CZECHOSLOVAKIA INVASION ISSUE FROM THE UNITED NATIONS SECURITY COUNCIL, WHERE THE SOVIET UNION HAS THE RIGHT OF VETO, TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, IT WAS OFFICIALLY ANNOUNCED HERE.

FOREIGN MINISTER ANTONIO CARRILLO FLORES SAID INSTRUCTIONS TO THIS EFFECT WERE SENT TO THE MEXICAN CHIEF DELEGATE TO THE UNITED NATIONS, FRANCISCO CUEVAS CANCINO, AT THE EXPRESS ORDERS OF PRESIDENT GUSTAVO DIAZ ORDAZ.

THE MEXICAN GOVERNMENT WOULD SEEK THE SUPPORT OF ALL THE LATIN AMERICAN COUNTRIES AT THE U.N.
