X/4 C/S -- COMMUNIST MEETING MADE IMPOSSIBLE, RADIO SAYS

MUNICH, AUG 25 (CMD) -- THE CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO STATION "ON THE DANUBE" BROADCASTING IN SLOVAK, SAID TODAY THOSE WHO DECIDED ABOUT THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA MUST KNOW THAT THEY "MADE IMPOSSIBLE" THE WORLD CONFERENCE OF COMMUNIST PARTIES PLANNED FOR MOSCOW LATER THIS YEAR.

THE RADIO SAID THE COMMUNIST PARTIES IN THE WEST WILL BE DISCREDITED FOR A LONG TIME.

IN THE WHOLE WORKERS MOVEMENT UNDOUBTEDLY THE CONVICTION WILL SPREAD THAT "MOSCOW IS RETURNING TO THE YEARS OF TOUGH CONTROL" OVER THAT PART OF THE COMMUNIST MOVEMENT WHICH IT STILL HAS," THE RADIO SAID.

IT SAID THE GOVERNMENT OF WESTERN COUNTRIES WILL "INEVITABLY" CONSIDER THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA AS A "BASIC TURN" IN SOVIET FOREIGN POLICY AND AS A RETURN TO THE "TOUGH, MERCILESS POLICY FROM THE WORST PERIOD OF THE COLD WAR."
