X/4 CS - NEPSZAVA ATTACKS CEAUSESCU

MUNICH, AUG 25 (CMD)- ANOTHER HUNGARIAN NEWSPAPER ATTACKED RUMANIAN COMMUNIST PARTY LEADER AND PRESIDENT NICOLAE CEAUSESCU TODAY.

NEPSZAVA SAID CEAUSESCU HAD MADE A STRANGE SUPPOSITION IN SAYING THAT RUMANIA'S ALLIES FELT THEMSELVES THREATENED BY SOCIALIST DEMOCRACY.

(CMD: SEVERAL HUNGARIAN NEWSPAPERS ATTACKED CEAUSESCU YESTERDAY.)

ACCORDING TO MTI TODAY, NEPSZAVA SAID WHOEVER INSTIGATED NATIONALIST SENTIMENTS AND MISUSED MASS INFLUENCE BY APPLYING A MIRROR OF DISTORTION INSTEAD OF MAKING A SCIENTIFIC ANALYSIS ASSUMED A GRAVE RESPONSIBILITY.

THEN, REFERRING DIRECTLY TO CEAUSESCU, THE NEWSPAPER SAID:

"THE HEAD OF STATE OF THE WARSAW PACT MEMBER RUMANIAN SOCIALIST REPUBLIC IS WORRYING OVER THE ACTION OF THE WARSAW PACT COUNTRIES AND HE GOES TO THE EXTENT OF CHARGING IN TERMS OF EXCITEMENT AND DISTRACTION THE ALLIED FORCES WHO STOOD UP TO DEFEND THE CZECHOSLOVAK WORKING PEOPLE'S POWER.

"IN HIS VIEW IT WAS NOT THE LONG MONTHS OF EXTREMIST AGITATION THAT HAD DISTURBED LIFE, PEACEFUL WORK AND GOVERNMENT ACTIVITY IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA, NO, IT WAS THE DAWN OF AUGUST 21 THAT HAS DONE SO.

"TO SUPPOSE THAT THE PEOPLE WHO ARE BUILDING THE SAME TYPE OF SOCIAL ORDER AND BELONG TO THE SAME MILITARY ALLIANCE AS RUMANIA, SHOULD REALLY FEEL THEMSELVES THREATENED BY THE SOCIALIST DEMOCRACY AND BY HUMANISM -- THIS IS A STRANGE SUPPOSITION, TO SAY THE LEAST OF IT.

"WHO SHOULD PROFIT BY SUCH AN ATTITUDE IS A QUESTION WHICH WE FEEL NEEDS NO ANSWER," NEPSZAVA SAID.
