X/4 C/S - SLOVAK CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEETS

MUNICH, AUG 25 (CMD) - A SESSION OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF THE SLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY, WHICH MET IN BRATISLAVA TODAY, DECIDED ON SEVERAL CHANGES IN ITS PRESIDIUM AND DEPRIVED FORMER CHAIRMAN OF THE SLOVAK NATIONAL COUNCIL MICHAL CHUDIK OF HIS CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP.

IT IS ALSO DISCUSSING THE SLOVAK PARTY CONGRESS.

THE SLOVAK-LANGUAGE RADIO "ON THE DANUBE" SAID CHUDIK LEFT THE MEETING AFTER THE BODY TOOK THE DECISION.

THE PLENARY SESSION ALSO DECIDED THAT STEFAN SADOVSKY, VOJTECH MICHALIK, CZECHOSLOVAK DEPUTY PREMIER PETER COLOTKA, AND JAN KOSCELANSKY BECOME NEW MEMBERS OF THE SLOVAK PARTY PRESIDIUM.

THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE ALSO AGREED THAT ROBERT HARENCAR AND KOLOMAN BODA WHO ARE NOW PRESIDIUM CANDIDATES BECOME NORMAL PRESIDIUM MEMBERS.

LACO NOVOMESKY, A COMMUNIST LEADER SENTENCED DURING THE PERSONALITY CULT PERIOD TO A LONG IMPRISONMENT TERM AND LATER REHABILITATED, AND A MAN NAMED ABRAHAM WERE ELECTED MEMBERS OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE SECRETARIAT.

PRESIDIUM MEMBER VIKTOR PAVLENDIA REPORTED BRIEFLY TO THE SESSION ABOUT THE PRESENT SITUATION AND SUMMARIZED THE PRESIDIUM'S WORK SINCE THE FIRST MOMENTS OF THE OCCUPATION BY WARSAW PACT TROOPS.
