PAVLENDA ALSO PRESENTED A DETAILED REPORT ABOUT PERSONAL PHONE CALLS WHICH TOOK PLACE FRIDAY AND SATURDAY BETWEEN A DELEGATION OF THE SLOVAK PRESIDUM AND CZECHOSLOVAK PARTY LEADER ALEXANDER DUBCEK AND DEPUTY PREMIER GUSTAV HUSAK.

RADIO ON THE DANUBE SAID THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE SESSION IS CONTINUING.

IT SAID THAT ON THE AGENDA NOW IS THE DESIRE OF DUBCEK, HUSAK, PREMIER OLDRICH CERNIK, NATIONAL ASSEMBLY CHAIRMAN JOSEF SMRKOVSKY AND PRESIDENT LUDVIK SVOBODA TO "WAIT WITH THE CONVOCAION OF THE EXTRAORDINARY CONGRESS OF THE SLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY UNTIL THEY RETURN."

THE RADIO SAID THIS REPORT WAS SIGNED BY PRESIDUM MEMBERS JOZEF ZRAK, JAN JANIK AND PAVLEND.

THE RADIO THEN SAID THEY (THE RADIO ... CMD) TRUSTED DUBCEK AND THE OTHER PEOPLE WITHOUT RESERVATION, BUT ADDED THAT AT THE SAME TIME REPORTS ARE ARRIVING FROM VARIOUS DIRECTIONS SAYING THAT THE CONGRESS BE HELD AS SCHEDULED. (THE CONGRESS HAS BEEN SCHEDULED FOR MONDAY.)
