THE RADIO THEN SAID IT WAS "UNDERSTANDABLE THAT OUR PUBLIC IS MISLEAD BY THESE CONTRADICTORY REPORTS."

"THEREFORE," THE RADIO SAID, "WE OFFER FOR CONSIDERATION:

"FIRSTLY -- ARE OUR CLOSEST REPRESENTATIVES DUBCEK, SVOBODA, SMRKOVSKY, CERNIK, HUSAK, IN SUCH A POSITION THAT THEY CAN FREELY DECIDE ? ARE WE AT ALL ABLE TO CONFIRM THAT THIS IS THEIR VIEW?

"SECONDLY -- UNDER THE REPORT ABOUT THE POSTPONEMENT ... THERE ARE MISSING THE SIGNATURES OF (ANTON) TAZKY, (TURCEK ?), TWO OTHER MEN WHOM WE IN SLOVAKIA ABSOLUTELY TRUST. ON THE OTHER HAND, COMRADE JANIK DOES NOT RPT NOT ENJOY THIS CONFIDENCE ANY MORE ...

"THIRDLY -- IF THE POSTPONEMENT OF THE CONGRESS IS SO IMPORTANT FOR THE SOVIET SIDE SO THAT IT MENTIONS THIS DEMAND ON THE LEVEL WITH OUR DEMAND FOR THE DEPARTURE OF THE OCCUPATION ARMIES IT IS PROVING HOW VERY IMPORTANT THE HOLDING OF THE CONGRESS AT A CERTAIN DATE IS."

THE RADIO THEN CALLED ON PAVLEND, ZRAK, TURCEK AND TAZKY TO CONSIDER THIS AND TAKE A CLEAR STAND AS THEIR DECISION WOULD "INFLUENCE THE FATE OF US ALL." (RADIO ON THE DANUBE DOMESTIC/M, AUG 25, 1144)
