X/4 CS - FREE PRAGUE ON MOSCOW TALKS

MUNICH, AUG 25 (CMD) - RADIO FREE PRAGUE SAID TODAY THAT THERE WERE THREE THEORIES ABOUT THE MOSCOW TALKS BETWEEN A CZECHOSLOVAK DELEGATION AND SOVIET LEADERS.

THE RADIO SAID THE TALKS AMONG "OUR REPRESENTATIVES, THE COLLABORATORS AND THE MOSCOW STALINISTS" CONTINUE IN MOSCOW.

INCREASED PRESSURE INSIDE CZECHOSLOVAKIA "COULD BE AN INDICATION OF THE UNYIELDINGNESS OF THE SVOBODA AND DUBCEK GROUP AND AT THE SAME TIME ALSO OF A FAILURE OF (ALOIS) INDRA'S POLICY," THE RADIO SAID.

"HOWEVER, THERE IS ANOTHER POSSIBILITY: THE MASS REINFORCEMENTS AND THE STEPPING UP OF REPRESSSIONS COULD BE A PRELUDE FOR A DIMINISHING GLORY," THE RADIO ADDED.

"AND THE THIRD VERSION IS QUITE SIMPLE: ONE CANNOT EXCLUDE THE POSSIBILITY THAT THE OCCUPIERS HAVE DECIDED IN FAVOR OF A DECISIVE SUPPRESSION OF THE ENTIRE CZECHOSLOVAK ADMINISTRATION AND OF THE PARTY BODIES," RADIO FREE PRAGUE DECLARED. (RADIO FREE PRAGUE, AUG 25, 0558)
