

C/S - CS OFFICIAL CORRECTS ALGERIAN VERSION

ALGIERS, AUG 25 (UPI) - THE CZECHOSLOVAK CHARGE D'AFFAIRS IN ALGIERS HAS SENT A LETTER TO ALL FOREIGN EMBASSIES HERE TO CORRECT THE ALGERIAN GOVERNMENT'S FAILURE TO GIVE INFORMATION ON THE INVASION EXCEPT THE OFFICIAL MOSCOW LINE CARRIED BY THE TASS NEWS AGENCY.

"BEING GIVEN ONLY INFORMATION ON CZECHOSLOVAKIA PUBLISHED IN THE ALGERIAN PRESS BASED ON THE COMMUNIQUEES AND BULLETINS OF THE AGENCY TASS, MY DUTY IS TO LET YOU KNOW THE REAL ATTITUDE OF THE GOVERNMENT I REPRESENT HERE," JOSEF DVORAK, THE CZECHOSLOVAK CHARGE D'AFFAIRS, WROTE.

"OUR LEGAL GOVERNMENT CONSIDERS THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA AS A FEROCIOUS ATTACK AGAINST ITS INDEPENDENCE, A VIOLATION WITHOUT PRECEDENT OF ITS SOVEREIGNTY, AND UNPARALLELED ILLEGALITY. NEITHER THE GOVERNMENT NOR ANY CONSTITUTIONAL AUTHORITY HAS EVER ASKED FOR THE INTERVENTION OF FOREIGN COUNTRIES IN OUR INTERNAL AFFAIRS AND THUS NEITHER INVASION, NOR OCCUPATION."

"OUR PEOPLE UNANIMOUSLY SUPPORT THEIR LEADERS AND WILL CONTINUE THEIR RESISTENCE TO OBTAIN THE EVACUATION OF THE SOVIET, HUNGARIAN, POLISH, GERMAN AND BULGARIAN TROOPS," DVORAK WROTE.
