X/4 C/S -- ZAGREB: THREE CS PLANES HELD BY BULGARIANS

MUNICH, AUG 25 (CMD) -- A GROUP OF 95 CZECHOSLOVAK TOURISTS ARRIVED IN YUGOSLAVIA FROM BULGARIA YESTERDAY AFTER THE BULGARIANS HELD BACK THREE CZECHOSLOVAK PASSENGER PLANES THAT SHOULD HAVE TAKEN THE TOURISTS BACK TO CZECHOSLOVAKIA, RADIO ZAGREB REPORTED TODAY.

THE RADIO SAID THE TOURISTS WERE EMPLOYEES OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK AVIATION COMPANY, AND THE THREE II-18 PLANES BELONGED TO THEIR COMPANY. BULGARIAN AUTHORITIES HELD BACK ONE OF THE PLANES IN BURGAS ON THE BLACK SEA AND TWO IN SOFIA, IT SAID.

RADIO ZAGREB ALSO SAID THAT YUGOSLAV CITIZENS IN DIMITROVGRAD HAD EXPRESSED THEIR READINESS TO RENDER HELP AND HOSPITALITY TO THE CZECHOSLOVAKS. (RADIO ZAGREB, DOMESTIC/M AUG 25; 1300)
