X/4 C/S - 2ND ADD - YUGOSLAV PARTY (CN 207) XXX PRESSURE

THE YUGOSLAV RESOLUTION CRITICISED WHAT IT CALLED "BLOC POLICIES" AND SAID: "THE INTERVENTION CONFIRMS ONCE AGAIN THAT THE BLOC POLICY DOES NOT SECURE EITHER JUST PEACE OR INDEPENDENCE.

"IT GIVES INCENTIVE TO THE FORMATION OF SPHERES OF INTEREST AMONG BIG POWERS, PRESSURE UPON SMALL COUNTRIES TO DECLARE THEMSELVES FOR THE BIG, BUT GIVES NO INCENTIVE TO THE OVERCOMING OF HEGEMONY, VIOLENCE AND INTERFERENCE IN THE INTERNAL AFFAIRS OF OTHERS."

"THE LEAGUE OF COMMUNISTS OF YUGOSLAVIA," SAID THE DOCUMENT, "DOES NOT RECOGNIZE ANY AGREEMENTS - OPEN OR TACIT - ON SPHERES OF INTEREST, WHICH CHANGE SMALL PEOPLES INTO AN OBJECT OF THE POLICY FROM THE POSITION OF FORCE.

"THE RESOLUTION RECALLS THAT THE LEAGUE OF COMMUNISTS OF YUGOSLAVIA OPPOSED THE YALTA TREATY ON THE DIVISION OF SPHERES OF INFLUENCE OF BIG POWERS AND THAT IT WILL ALSO OPPOSE ANY AGREEMENT TO THE DETRIMENT OF OTHER PEOPLES.

"THE POLICY OF DIVISION OF SPHERES OF INTEREST AND HEGEMONY OF BIG POWERS IS NOT ONLY MISFORTUNE FOR PEOPLES, BUT ALSO INCESSANT THREAT TO PEACE IN THE WORLD."
