X/4 C/S - CALLS ON FOREIGN TROOPS TO GO HOME

MUNICH, AUG 26 (CMD)- CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO STATIONS YESTERDAY CALLED ON THE OCCUPATION TROOPS IN THEIR OWN LANGUAGES TO GO HOME.

RADIO PLZEN TOLD THE EAST GERMAN SOLDIERS THAT ALL CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE BACKED DUBCEK, AND THAT THIS HAD NOTHING TO DO WITH A COUNTER-REVOLUTION.

"IF YOU BELIEVE THAT MILLIONS OF CZECHOSLOVAKS ARE COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARIES RAISE YOUR WEAPONS AGAINST US, AND DESTROY OUR FRIENDSHIP FOR EVER. IF YOU DO NOT BELIEVE THAT, THEN PROTEST," IT SAID.

RADIO SOUTH MORAVIA BROADCAST AN APPEAL IN POLISH TO THE POLISH CITY OF POZNAN WHICH IS A "TWIN" OF BRNO. IT SAID THAT POLISH SOLDIERS IN THE ROLE OF OCCUPIERS IN THE CSSR "CAN SEE EVERYDAY THAT THEY HAVE BEEN CHEATED. THEY CAN SEE THERE IS NO COUNTER-REVOLUTION, AND THAT NOBODY IS SHOOTING AT THEM.

RADIO KOSICE BROADCAST AN APPEAL TO HUNGARIAN SOLDIERS.

"GO HOME," RADIO KOSICE SAID. "THERE YOU CAN SERVE YOUR COUNTRY IN A BETTER WAY."
