

MUNICH, AUG 26 (CNR)- DEVELOPMENTS SURROUNDING THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA BY SOVIET AND OTHER WARSAW PACT FORCES DOMINATE WORLD NEWS AGAIN TODAY.

HEADLINING THE DEVELOPMENTS ARE CRUCIAL TALKS IN MOSCOW BETWEEN CZECHOSLOVAK AND SOVIET LEADERS -- NOW IN THEIR FOURTH DAY.

THE PARTY LEADERS OF POLAND, HUNGARY, BULGARIA AND EAST GERMANY - WHOSE TROOPS TOOK PART WITH THE SOVIETS IN THE INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA ARE REPORTED TO HAVE ARRIVED IN MOSCOW AND ARE EXPECTED TO JOIN IN THE TALKS.

AS WORLD-WIDE PROTESTS AGAINST THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA CONTINUE THE EAST EUROPEAN SITUATION REMAINS AT CRISIS POINT. THE WORLD ANXIOUSLY AWAITS THE OUTCOME OF INCREASING PRESS AND RADIO ATTACKS BY THE WARSAW PACT NATIONS AGAINST RUMANIA AND YUGOSLAVIA-- STRONG SUPPORTERS OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THERE IS ALSO CONCERN IN VIETNAM FOR SOUTH VIETNAMESE TROOPS BESEIGED BY A HUGE NORTH VIETNAMESE FORCE IN A JUNGLE ENCAMPMENT NEAR THE CAMBODIAN BORDER. ALLIED REINFORCEMENTS HAVE BEEN RUSHED TO THE AREA.

THE VIETNAM WAR WILL FIGURE PROMINENTLY IN SPEECHES AT THE DEMOCRATIC NATIONAL CONVENTION WHICH OPENS IN CHICAGO TODAY. A BITTER FIGHT OVER THE ISSUE IS EXPECTED BEFORE THE PARTY PLATFORM IS ANNOUNCED.
