

X/4 C/S - SOVIET'S WARSAW PACT ALLIES FOR MOSCOW TALKS (W/ CN 17)

MUNICH, AUGUST 26 (CMD)- RADIO FREE PRAGUE, REPORTING ON THE SOVIET-CZECHOSLOVAK TALKS IN MOSCOW, SAID TODAY THAT REPRESENTATIVES OF THE OTHER COUNTRIES OCCUPYING CZECHOSLOVAKIA ARE SUPPOSED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE TALKS TODAY.

HOWEVER IT NOTED THAT OFFICIAL MOSCOW QUARTERS HAD NOT RPT NOT CONFIRMED THE REPORT.

THE RADIO NAMED BULGARIAN PARTY LEADER TODOR ZHIVKOV, POLISH PARTY LEADER WLADYSLAW GOMULKA, HUNGARIAN PARTY LEADER JANOS KADAR, AND EAST GERMAN PARTY LEADER WALTER ULBRICHT AS AMONG THOSE SAID TO BE JOINING THE TALKS.

THE BROADCAST ALSO NOTED THAT THE SOVIET NEWS AGENCY TASS HAD SAID IN ITS REPORT THAT THE TALKS WERE TAKING PLACE IN A COMRADELY AND FRANK ATMOSPHERE. (RADIO FREE PRAGUE DOMESTIC, M, AUGUST 26, 0510)
