A CZECHOSLOVAK EMBASSY OFFICIAL SAID LATER THE SOVIET EMBASSY HAD BEEN MAKING CONTRADICTIONARY STATEMENTS ABOUT NADAS' WHEREABOUTS.

SECOND SECRETARY VACLAV CERVENY SAID THE SOVIET PRESS ATTACHE HAD TELEPHONED THE CZECHOSLOVAK EMBASSY AT MIDDAY TODAY AND SAID NADA HAD APPLIED FOR A SOVIET VISA, BUT THAT HE DID NOT KNOW WHERE SHE WAS.

MR. CERVENY SAID: "THIS IS A CONTRADICTION. SHE WAS ABDUCTED BY A RUSSIAN-SPEAKING COUPLE AND DRIVEN OFF IN A CAR."

HE SAID NADA SPENT THE FIRST NIGHT OF HER VISIT TO ENGLAND AT THE RESIDENCE OF CZECHOSLOVAK AMBASSADOR MILOSLAV RUZEK. "SHE HAD THREE STERLING." WHO PAID FOR HER FLIGHT TO MOSCOW, HE ASKED.
