

X/9 CS - WARSAW: COUNTER- REVOLUTION'S TO BE STRANGLED

WARSAW, AUG 26, (UPI) - THE PARTY NEWSPAPER TRYBUNA LUDU VOWED IN AN EDITORIAL TODAY THAT THE CZECHOSLOVAK "COUNTER-REVOLUTION" WOULD BE "STRANGLED."

"COUNTER-REVOLUTION WILL NOT PROCEED. THE FORCES WILL BE STRANGLED. THE SOVIET UNION, POLAND, AND OTHER COUNTRIES BELONGING TO THE WARSAW TREATY ARE DETERMINED TO SOLVE THE CZECH CRISIS IN A WAY CORRESPONDING TO THE INTERESTS OF ALL SOCIALIST COUNTRIES AND THUS PRESERVE THE SOVEREIGNTY AND SUCCESSFUL DEVELOPMENT OF SOCIALIST CZECHOSLOVAKIA," TRYBUNA SAID.

ZOLNIERCA WOLNOSCI, THE POLISH ARMED FORCES NEWSPAPER, TODAY REPORTED THE LOSS OF A POLISH TANK "DUE TO A ROAD ACCIDENT."

CORP. RYSZARD KUCHARCZYK WAS KILLED ON THE SPOT AND OTHER MEMBERS OF THE CREW WERE INJURED, THE PAPER SAID.
