X/4 -- CS-CZECHOSLOVAK POWER MINISTER RETURNS FROM MOSCOW

MUNICH, AUG. 26 (CMD) -- CZECHOSLOVAK POWER MINISTER JOSEF KORCAK RETURNED TO PRAGUE TODAY FROM MOSCOW WHERE HE PARTICIPATED IN AN INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE OF POWER INDUSTRY WORKERS, RADIO FREE CENTRAL BOHEMIA REPORTED.

KORCAK, WHO ARRIVED IN PRAGUE YESTERDAY, SAID HE AGREED WITH ALL ACTIONS TAKEN BY THE GOVERNMENT DURING HIS ABSENCE, A GOVERNMENT REPORT QUOTED BY THE RADIO SAID.

AT A MEETING TODAY, THE REPORT SAID, THE GOVERNMENT ENDORSED MEASURES TAKEN BY THE FINANCE MINISTRY, THE STATE BANK AND LEADING ADMINISTRATORS OF COMMUNICATION TO ENSURE ALLOWANCES.

THE RADIO SAID THAT THE GOVERNMENT MEETING ALSO DEALT WITH PROBLEMS IN TRANSPORT AND BANKING FACILITIES AS A RESULT OF THE OCCUPATION.

IN A LATER REPORT, RADIO FREE CENTRAL BOHEMIA SAID THAT AN UNIDENTIFIED GOVERNMENT REPRESENTATIVE WOULD REPORT TO THE PRESIDUM OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY, WHICH WAS TO MEET TODAY.

PARLIAMENT HAS BEEN IN SESSION FOR FIVE DAYS, THE RADIO SAID.

THE GOVERNMENT REPRESENTATIVE WILL INFORM THE PRESIDUM OF THE PROGRESS OF THE MOSCOW TALKS AND THE MEASURES TAKEN BY THE GOVERNMENT TO PROTECT THE RIGHTS OF CZECHOSLOVAKS AND THEIR PROPERTY DURING THE OCCUPATION.
