

CZECHOSLOVAK STUDENTS FORM ORGANIZATION

LONDON, AUGUST 26--(RFE SPECIAL/HOOD)--VLADIMIR SKOUMAL, A BRITISH SUBJECT BORN OF CZECHOSLOVAK PARENTS, ANNOUNCED TODAY A GROUP OF STRANDED CZECHOSLOVAK STUDENTS HAS FORMED AN ORGANIZATION TO SET UP A CENTRAL CLEARING HOUSE FOR OFFERS OF WORK AND ACCOMODATION.

THE BODY HAS BEEN GIVEN THE NAME "EUVENTUS", CZECH FOR "YOUTH", WITH OFFICES IN THE NOTTING HILL SECTION OF WEST LONDON.

THE BRITISH WRITERS GUILD YESTERDAY ADED THE FORMATION OF A BRITISH GROUP TO HELP FIND HOUSING, JOBS AND FUNDS FOR STUDENTS, AND TWO YOUTH GROUPS IN BRITAIN ARE ALSO SERVING AS A CLEARING HOUSE FOR SIMILAR OFFERS, BUT EUVENTUS IS THE FIRST ORGANIZATION FORMED BY CZECHOSLOVAK STUDENTS THEMSELVES TO BE ANNOUNCED HERE.

MUNICH, AUG 26 (CMD) - THE YUGOSLAV NEWS AGENCY TANJUG SAID THIS AFTERNOON THAT THE CZECHOSLOVAK AMBASSADOR TO BELGRADE, LADISLAV SIMOVIC, PAID A CALL TODAY ON YUGOSLAV FEDERAL ASSEMBLY PRESIDENT MILENTIJE POPOVIC.

PEACE DELEGATION SEES SIK IN BELGRADE

MUNICH, AUG 26 (CMD) - THE YUGOSLAV NEWS AGENCY TANJUG SAID THIS AFTERNOON THAT CZECHOSLOVAK DEPUTY PREMIER OTA SIK MET TODAY IN BELGRADE WITH A DELEGATION OF THE INTERNATIONAL CONFEDERATION FOR DISARMAMENT AND PEACE.

TANJUG SAID THE DELEGATION GAVE SIK, WHO WAS IN BELGRADE WHEN HIS COUNTRY WAS INVADED, A COPY OF A RESOLUTION ON CZECHOSLOVAKIA THAT THE CONFEDERATION HAD PASSED AT A MEETING IN LJUBLJANA. (TANJUG, AUG 26, 1405)
