

C/S -- NEW DELEGATION SUGGESTED FOR MOSCOW

(ATtribution REQUIRED)

MUNICH, AUG 26 (CNR)-- THE CZECHOSLOVAK PARTY AND GOVERNMENT HAS SUGGESTED TO THE CZECHOSLOVAK DELEGATION IN MOSCOW THAT A GOVERNMENT, PARTY AND PARLIAMENTARY DELEGATION SHOULD GO TO MOSCOW TO INFORM THE DELEGATION IN THE SOVIET CAPITAL OF THE SITUATION INSIDE CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

GIVING DETAILS THIS AFTERNOON OF THE LETTER, RADIO PRAGUE IN ENGLISH SAID THAT ALTERNATIVELY THE LETTER SUGGESTED THAT THE TALKS SHOULD BE INTERRUPTED TO ENABLE THE CZECHOSLOVAK REPRESENTATIVES IN MOSCOW TO RETURN TO PRAGUE.

THE LETTER SAID THAT "THE INFORMATION WHICH THE CZECHOSLOVAK DELEGATION IS RECEIVING IN MOSCOW IS BIASED AND INCOMPLETE," THE RADIO CAST SAID.

ANOTHER POINT MADE BY THE LETTER WAS THAT TENSION WAS INCREASING AND IN THE FIRST THREE DAYS OF THE OCCUPATION THERE WERE THIRTY PEOPLE KILLED AND 300 INJURED.

HERE IS THE PARTIAL TEXT OF THE BROADCAST:

"HERE IS A SUMMARY OF THE LETTER WHICH THE PRESIDUM OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK PARLIAMENT THE GOVERNMENT AND THE PRESIDUM OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA SENT YESTERDAY TO THE CZECHOSLOVAK DELEGATION NEGOTIATING IN MOSCOW.

IT INFORMS PRESIDENT SVOBODA AND THE MEMBERS OF THE DELEGATION OF THE SITUATION IN THE COUNTRY, ASSURING THEM THAT THE CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE ARE UNITED IN THEIR CONDEMNATION OF THE OCCUPATION OF THEIR COUNTRY AS AN UNLAWFUL ACT.

AND DEMANDED THE WITHDRAWAL OF THE OCCUPATION UNITS.
