CS - INTERNATIONAL LAW ASSOCIATION URGES U.N. ACT ON CZECHOSLOVAKIA

BUENOS AIRES, AUG. 26, REUTER -- THE INTERNATIONAL LAW ASSOCIATION (ILA) TODAY URGED THE UNITED NATIONS TO TAKE ALL PEACEFUL STEPS UNDER ITS CHARTER TO RESTORE SOVERIGNTY AND INDEPENDENCE TO CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

A RESOLUTION PASSED BY THE FULL COUNCIL OF THE ASSOCIATION AND READ BY LORD WILBERFORCE, PRESIDENT OF THE ILA EXECUTIVE COUNCIL, SAID THE ASSOCIATION WAS DEEPLY CONCERNED WITH EVENTS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THE ASSOCIATION TODAY OPENED ITS 53RD BI-ANNUAL CONGRESS HERE.
