

X/4 C/S -- RADIO SAYS NATIONAL ASSEMBLY PRESIDUM MEETING

MUNICH, AUG 26 (CMD)-- RADIO FREE CENTRAL BOHEMIA REPORTS THAT THE PRESIDUM OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK NATIONAL ASSEMBLY WAS TO MEET THIS AFTER-NOON, AND DISCUSS THE SITUATION IN MOSCOW.

THE RADIO SAID THE MEETING WAS TO BEGIN AT 1445 MT.

"WE WILL INFORM YOU OF ITS COURSE," THE RADIO TOLD ITS LISTENERS.

ACCORDING TO A PRELIMINARY REPORT, THE RADIO SAID, THE MOSCOW TALKS HAD BEEN JOINED BY THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE FOUR COUNTRIES, WHICH , TOGETHER WITH THE SOVIET UNION, HAD OCCUPIED CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

TALKING ABOUT CONDITIONS AT THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY BUILDING, THE RADIO SAID THAT THERE HAD BEEN NO RPT NO CHANGE, TANKS AND MILITARY EQUIPMENT WERE STILL OUTSIDE THE BUILDING.

THE RADIO SAID THE PARLIAMENTARY PRESIDUM "APPRECIATED THE UNAMBIGUOUS AND FIRM POLITICAL ATTITUDE OF THE WORKING PEOPLE, FULLY SUPPORTING THE STANDPOINT OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY, OUR GOVERNMENT, PRESIDENT AND ALSO THE NEWLY ELECTED CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY."

THE PRESIDUM ALSO SUPPORTED THE 15-MINUTE NATIONWIDE PROTEST AT 0900 MT THIS MORNING, WHEN ALL SIRENS, FACTORY HOOTERS, BELLS, ENGINE WHISTLES AND CAR HORNS WERE SOUNDED IN PROTEST TO THE OCCUPATION, THE RADIO SAID.
