X/13 BERLIN -- CITY GOVERNMENT MEETS ON CSSR EVENTS

BERLIN, AUG 26 (RFE SPECIAL/SCHLEICH) -- "A NUMBER OF POLITICAL QUESTIONS WHICH HAVE RESULTED FROM THE DEVELOPMENT IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA" ARE BEING DISCUSSED THIS AFTERNOON BY THE WEST BERLIN CITY GOVERNMENT (SENAT), ACCORDING TO A SPOKESMAN.

THE SENATORS ARE MEETING WITH GOVERNING MAYOR KLAUS SCHUETZ AT CITY HALL, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

THE SPOKESMAN ALSO ANNOUNCED THAT SCHUETZ WILL FLY TO BONN TOMORROW IN HIS CAPACITY AS PRESIDENT OF THE BUNDESRAT, THE REPRESENTATION OF THE WEST GERMAN LAENDER, TO SUBSTITUTE FOR FEDERAL PRESIDENT HEINRICH LUEBKE.

(BY PROTOCOL, THE PRESIDENT OF THE BUNDESRAT IS ACTING CHIEF OF STATE IN THE ABSENCE OF THE FEDERAL PRESIDENT.)

SCHUETZ IS EXPECTED TO RETURN TO BERLIN TOMORROW NIGHT.
