X/4 C/S -- MOSCOW TALKS CONTINUE

(ATTRIBUTION REQUIRED)

MUNICH, AUG 26 (CMD)-- RADIO FREE PRAGUE TONIGHT QUOTED CZECHOSLOVAK PREMIER OLDRICH CERNIK AS HAVING TOLD DEPUTY PREMIER LUBOMIR STROUGAL BY TELEPHONE THAT THE SOVIET-CZECHOSLOVAK TALKS IN MOSCOW ARE CONTINUING.

HERE IS THE TEXT OF THE BROADCAST:

"AT HALF PAST EIGHT TONIGHT DEPUTY PREMIER COMRADE STROUGAL CONTACTED BY TELEPHONE COMRADE CERNIK IN MOSCOW.

"COMRADE CERNIK INFORMED COMRADE STROUGAL THAT UP TO NOW THE NEGOTIATIONS CONTINUE AND THAT NOW THEY DISCUSS THE MOST IMPORTANT QUESTIONS.

"OUR DELEGATION IS MAKING EFFORTS FOR A SPEEDY CONCLUSION OF THE NEGOTIATIONS AND A RETURN HOME.

"COMRADE CERNIK CONFIRMED THAT THE DELEGATION KNOWS ABOUT INFORMATIONS FORWARDED TO IT BY THE GOVERNMENT ABOUT THE SITUATION IN THE COUNTRY.

"HE ALSO CONFIRMED THAT HE WILL INFORM CONSTITUTIONAL BODIES AND THE PUBLIC AFTER THE RETURN OF THE DELEGATION HOME.

"ON THIS OCCASION, PREMIER COMRADE CERNIK FORWARDED GREETINGS IN HIS OWN NAME AND IN THE NAME OF THE WHOLE DELEGATION TO ALL CZECHOSLOVAK CITIZENS."
