X/4 C/S -- CENTRAL COMMITTEE TO DISCUSS SITUATION, TALKS
(RELEADS CN 66)

MUNICH, AUG 26 (CMD)-- THE CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO REPORTED TONIGHT THAT THE SESSION OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE WHICH WILL MEET TOMORROW WILL DISCUSS THE SITUATION IN THE COUNTRY SINCE THE BEGINNING OF THE OCCUPATION AND THE MOSCOW TALKS.

THE RADIO SAID IN AN ENGLISH-LANGUAGE BROADCAST JOURNALISTS HAD BEEN INFORMED ABOUT THIS AT A PRESS CONFERENCE WITH TWO MEMBERS OF THE PARTY LEADERSHIP HELD IN PRAGUE TODAY. JOURNALISTS WERE ALSO TOLD ABOUT A MEETING OF THE PARTY PRESIDUM HELD TODAY.

AT THE PRESS CONFERENCE IT WAS PROPOSED THAT PRESIDENT LUDVIK SVOBODA SHOULD RETURN FROM MOSCOW AND THAT FURTHER NEGOTIATIONS WOULD BE HELD IN PRAGUE.

THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE PARTY LEADERSHIP SAID THEY WOULD INFORM THE PARTY PRESIDUM OF THIS DEMAND.

HERE IS THE FULL TEXT OF THE BROADCAST:

" A PRESS CONFERENCE WITH TWO MEMBERS OF THE LEADERSHIP OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA WAS HELD IN PRAGUE TODAY.

THE PRAGUE JOURNALISTS WHO WERE PRESENT WERE INFORMED OF THE MEETING OF THE PRESIDUM OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA WHICH MET TODAY AND OF THE MEETING OF THE PARTY'S CENTRAL COMMITTEE, WHICH IS TO BE HELD TOMORROW. THIS MEETING IS TO EVALUATE THE DEVELOPMENTS OF THE SITUATION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA OVER THE PAST SIX DAYS,

THAT IS SINCE THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA BY THE FIVE WARSAW PACT COUNTRIES ON THE 21ST (TWENTYFIRST) OF AUGUST.
