C/S -- BRITISH HOME OFFICE ON NADA BILAK (WITH CN 128)

LONDON, AUG 27, REUTER --- BRITAIN'S HOME OFFICE (INTERIOR MINISTRY) SAID MONDAY NIGHT IT APPEARED MISSING CZECHOSLOVAK GIRL NADA BILAK HAD FLOWN TO MOSCOW.

A HOME OFFICE SPOKESMAN SAID A PASSENGER WITH THE NAME OF NADA BILAK TRAVELLED ON A FLIGHT OF THE RUSSIAN AIRLINE AEROFLOT THURSDAY.

NADA, 17-YEAR-OLD DAUGHTER OF ONE OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST NEGOTIATING WITH THE SOVIET LEADERS, DISAPPEARED IN THE NORTH OF ENGLAND LAST THURSDAY.

"AMID REPORTS THAT SHE HAD BEEN ABDUCTED BY A RUSSIAN-SPEAKING COUPLE, THE SOVIET EMBASSY PRESS ATTACHE SAID EARLIER MONDAY: "SHE FLEW TO MOSCOW ALONE LAST THURSDAY."
