FREE CS TELEVISION WARNS OF MOSCOW OUTCOME  
VIENNA, AUG 27 (RFE SPECIAL/KOSTRBA/CNR)-- FREE CZECHOSLOVAKIA  
TELEVISION WARNED CZECHOSLOVAKS LAST NIGHT THAT THE OUTCOME OF  
THE CURRENT TALKS IN MOSCOW MIGHT NOT BE ENTIRELY SATISFACTORY FROM  
THE CZECHOSLOVAK POINT OF VIEW.

JUST BEFORE SIGNING OFF AT 2230 MT, THE TELEVISION ANNOUNCER SAID:  
"THERE SHOULD BE NO RPT NO ILLUSIONS HARBOURED BY CZECHOSLOVAK  
CITIZENS ABOUT THE OUTCOME OF THE MOSCOW TALKS.

"PERHAPS, THERE WILL BE A COMPROMISE, PERHAPS, A SEVERE RULE OF  
MILITARY OCCUPATION WILL SET IN. EVEN A COMPROMISE WILL MEAN SERIOUS  
CONCESSIONS, RETREATS AND DRAWBACKS SOME OF THEM MOST  
PROBABLY NOT ACCEPTABLE. IT IS MORE AND MORE OBVIOUS THAT THE SOVIETS  
ARE PLAYING FOR TIME. KNOWING THE CIRCUMSTANCES OF DUBCEK'S,  
CERNIKS AND SMRKOVSKYS ARRESTS, KNOWING WHAT MOSCOW PRAVDA HAD TO  
SAY ABOUT DUBCEK, IT IS IMPOSSIBLE TO ASSUME THAT OUR REPRESENTATIVES  
ARE BEING TREATED AS EQUAL PARTNERS BY THE SOVIETS," THE COMMENTATOR  
CONCLUDED.

CANADIAN STUDENTS CONDEMN INVASION

SOME 100 HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS FROM THE PROVINCE OF QUEBEC  
AND NEW YORK STATE FORMALLY CONDEMNED THE SOVIET UNIONS  
INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND URGED ITS IMMEDIATE WITHDRAWAL.

THESE STUDENTS PASSED A RESOLUTION TO THIS EFFECT SATURDAY  
AT THE END OF A WEEK LONG BILINGUAL SEMINAR AT THE  
UNIVERSITY OF MONTREAL. THESE STUDENTS ALSO WENT ON RECORD  
AS OPPOSING ANY MOVE BY THE SOVIET UNION AND ITS ALLIES TO INVADE  
RUMANIA. REPORTS OF SUCH PLANS HAD BEEN WIDELY CIRCULATED  
IN RECENT DAYS.
